Dwight is also proud of offer bursaries to the children of visiting academics and NGO leaders who often come to the UK via their respective embassies to work and learn at London's leading universities or

work in international charities and think-tanks—a gesture made in the spirit of professional collaboration with the expectation that these parent colleagues will demonstrate a willingness to share and support the school with their own professional expertise on areas of mutual institutional interest.
